Locally, more families are struggling to make ends meet because of low wages or lack of employment. The need for food assistance at both Crisis Control Ministry and Sunnyside Ministry continues to increase, not only among families, but also among the elderly. Globally, children are suffering from hunger and malnutrition. Lack of adequate water supplies, training, and tools prevent people from having adequate food sources. Natural disasters and the coronavirus pandemic have taken thousands of lives, leaving children orphaned and families homeless. There has never been a time when your time, energy, and financial support are more needed.
- **Your Congregations Impact** - When your congregation participates in the CROP Hunger Walk, you can be assured that your donations will touch lives in your community and around the world. Since 1979, the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County CROP Hunger Walk has brought together compassionate people to feed the hungry and change lives. Together, we have raised over **\$1,897,915** since our first CROP Hunger Walk. The funds raised are shared with Crisis Control Ministry (12.5%) and Sunnyside Ministry (12.5%) to feed our neighbors in need in Forsyth County. The remaining funds are shared with Church World Service (75%) to help in their hunger alleviation, food development, and disaster relief programs in 40 countries around the world, including the United States.
