THANK YOU for being a CROP Hunger Walk Team Captain! Your efforts encouraging your congregation to walk, give, and advocate to alleviate hunger in our community and around the world are vital. You are taking action against one of the greatest injustices facing the world today, hunger. With your leadership, we can feed our neighbors.

As a Winston-Salem/Forsyth County CROP Hunger Walk Team Captain, you make a difference!

- **You Understand the Need** - The impact of COVID-19 has had a detrimental effect on households across the globe. Locally, more families are struggling to make ends meet because of low wages. The need for food assistance at both Crisis Control Ministry and Sunnyside Ministry continues to increase, not only among families, but also among the elderly. Globally, children are suffering from hunger and malnutrition. Lack of adequate water supplies, training, and tools prevent people from having adequate food sources. Natural disasters and the coronavirus pandemic have taken thousands of lives, leaving children orphaned and families homeless. There has never been a time when your time, energy, and financial support are more needed.
- **Your Congregations Impact** - When your congregation participates in the CROP Hunger Walk, you can be assured that your donations will touch lives in your community and around the world. Since 1979, the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County CROP Hunger Walk has brought together compassionate people to feed the hungry and change lives. Together, we have raised over **\$2, 279,784** since our first CROP Hunger Walk. The funds raised are shared with Crisis Control Ministry (12.5%) and Sunnyside Ministry (12.5%) to feed our neighbors in need in Forsyth County. The remaining funds are shared with Church World Service (75%) to help in their hunger alleviation, food development, and disaster relief programs in 40 countries around the world, including the United States.
- **Your Enthusiasm** - Your energy and passion is contagious! You offer members of your congregation the opportunity to come together to be a part of ending hunger...one step at a time...one person at a time.

Please encourage members of your congregation to join the hundreds of other residents of Winston-Salem/Forsyth County as we come together to Walk, Give, and Change the World.

TEAM CAPTAIN'S CHECKLIST

1. GATHER YOUR WALK TEAM AND SET GOALS

- Enlist leaders in your congregation to help promote the walk.
- Set goals for your team.

2. PUBLICIZE AND PROMOTE THE WALK

- Share your CROP Hunger Walk story in your church newsletter
- Advertise in your church program/bulletin
- Advertise on social media (tag @cropwalkforsyth)
- Display posters and distribute flyers
- Visit www.cropwalkforsyth.org/resources for templates and ideas.
- Contact the Recruitment Chair at amccall@crisiscontrol.org for additional materials.

3. RECRUIT WALKERS

- Create your congregation's team, where members of your church can register for the walk, join your congregation's team, and donate online. Remember to include pictures! Go to www.cropwalkforsyth.org/register-online.html and refer to "[How to Use the Online Participation Fundraising Site](#)" in the Team Captain's Guide.
- Remember if members of your congregation aren't able to walk or choose not to walk this year, they can still "Walk in Spirit" and raise money.
- Prepare Walker Envelopes. See "[How to Sign Up Walkers/Team Members](#)" in the Team Captain's Guide.
- Give a walker envelope to each walker. Families or groups may use the same envelope. Envelopes are not required if acquiring donations online only.
- Provide a page of donor receipts for cash donations. Instruct walkers to make checks payable to **CWS/CROP**.
- Encourage your walkers to share the online fundraising website you created for your congregation with their friends and family to raise more money.
- Visit www.cropwalkforsyth.org/resources for exercise and activities to educate and encourage your walkers.
- Tell walkers how to get a FREE t-shirt. As a fundraising incentive, youth Walkers (under 12 years old) who raise \$50 and Walkers (13 years or older) who raise \$100 in donations will



receive a FREE Winston-Salem/Forsyth County CROP Hunger Walk T-Shirt. Reference [“How to Sign Up Walkers/Team Members”](#) in the Team Captain’s Guide.

4. PLAN FOR WALK DAY

- Decide if your team will be walking at Corpening Plaza on October 16th or walking remotely this year. Will your team members walk alone or with immediate family? Or will you walk in small groups following CDC and local guidelines.
- Will your congregation walk on October 16th, or will you walk on another date?
- How will you engage with your congregation on Walk Day? Will you host a crazy hat competition? Will your congregation walk with uniform signs?
- Make time for reflection and prayer. Refer to [Prayer in a Time of Pandemic](#) in the Team Captain’s Guide.

5. REGISTER YOUR TEAM FOR WALK DAY

- Remind your walkers to print out their “Online Donation Report” to turn in with their money and walker envelope. See [“How to Use the Online Participation Fundraising Site”](#) in the Team Captain’s Guide.
- Collect all walker envelopes.
- You may check-in early for your team at Crisis Control Ministry the week of October 3rd - 14th. Refer to [directions to Crisis Control Ministry](#). Please call or text 336-703-8282 if you need to come after hours.

6. THANK WALKERS

- After the walk, thank your walkers using email, personal note, church newsletter, or other communication tool.

7. POST WALK

- Want a t-shirt? Any remaining Walk shirts will be available at Crisis Control Ministry until Friday, November 11, 2022, or while supplies last.
- Please turn in all Walk donations by Friday, November 11, 2022.

HOW TO SIGN UP WALKERS/TEAM MEMBERS

PRIOR TO SIGNING UP WALKERS/TEAM MEMBERS

1. Set up your team at www.crophungerwalk.org/winstonsalemnc

Please note: Several churches have identical names, so be sure to use the full name of your team and town when creating your team online so we can give credit to the right team. (Examples: First Baptist Church – WS or First Baptist Church – Clemmons.)

2. Prepare Walker Envelopes

a. Fill in the top portion of the envelope:

- **Walk Name:** Winston-Salem/Forsyth County CROP Hunger Walk
- **Walk Date:** October 16, 2022
- **Congregation/School/Organization**

Please note: Several teams in the area have identical names, so be sure to put the full name of your team and town so we can give credit to the right team. (Examples: First Baptist Church – WS or First Baptist Church – Clemmons.)

b. Fill in the shaded portion:

- **Team Captain/Recruiter Name**
- **Team Captain/ Recruiter Email**
- **Team Captain/Recruiter Phone**

✓ Helpful Hint: Type and print labels with the information of (a) and (b) to stick on each envelope to save you from handwriting on the envelopes.

SIGNING UP WALKERS/TEAM MEMBERS

1. Give an envelope to each walker, family, or group walking together. An envelope is not necessary if walker or group is only acquiring donations online.



2. Record the number of the envelope given to walker(s) on the Recruiter's Packet.
3. Show walkers where to enter the following information:
 - Name, Address, Email, Phone Number, Number of Walkers represented by the envelope.
4. Show walkers where to sign "[Statement of Consent](#)" at the bottom. If child, parent will sign. If multiple walkers using the same envelope, give "[Consent Form for Multiple Walkers](#)" and instruct to have each walker sign and bring on walk day.
5. Encourage walkers to join your online team and fundraiser online.
6. Tell walkers how they can earn a FREE Winston-Salem/Forsyth County CROP Hunger Walk t-shirt for registering. Refer to [Team Captain's Checklist](#) for more information.

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR TEAM FOR WALK DAY

□ PRINT TEAM ONLINE REGISTRATION LISTING

1. Print the listing of your team members who have signed up to receive donations ONLINE and their total donations.

Refer to "[How to Use Online Participant Fundraising Site](#)".

□ VERIFY EACH WALKER ENVELOPE

1. Check each walker envelope for the following items to make sure the walker filled out the envelope correctly:
 - **Walker's name and contact information**
 - Number of walkers in family
 - Online donation report is included (If walker registered online and received donations)
 - Check and cash donations are included
 - Walker (or parent/guardian if youth) has signed the consent waiver form on the bottom of the walker envelope.
 - For several walkers using the same envelope, make sure you gave them a "[Consent Form for Multiple Walkers](#)" and all walkers have signed it.
 - The walk name, team name, and team captain information. You should have already filled out this section. Refer to "[How to Sign Up Walkers/Team Members](#)."

□ COLLECT ALL ENVELOPES (Put Team Name on Envelope)

1. Count money inside each envelope and verify the total matches' the walker's total. Please initial the outside of the envelope and mark the date you verified the money.
2. Add the walker(s) name and amount of donations to the back of the Team Captain's Envelope (aka the Recruiter's Packet).

✓ Helpful Hint: If possible, total all cash, write a check or get a money order for the amount **payable to CWS/CROP** and you keep the cash.

□ TALLY TEAM RESULTS

1. Fill in the back of your Team Captain's envelope.
2. Put all walker envelopes, inside.
3. Put the grand total of your team's fundraising on your envelope. Please initial and date beside.
4. Total the number of walkers for your team and put it on the outside of the envelope.

□ PICK UP T-SHIRTS

- Team Captains can pick up t-shirts for their team youth Walkers (under 12 years old) who raise \$50 and Walkers (13 years or older) who raise \$100 in donations at Crisis Control Ministry from **October 3-14, 2022**.
- After Walk day, any remaining t-shirts can be purchased for \$10 each at Crisis Control Ministry until **Friday, November 11, 2022**.

❑ **DROP OFF RECRUITER PACKETS**

- If you have collected your envelopes prior to the walk, you can drop those off at Crisis Control Ministry from **October 4-15, 2021**.
- After the walk if you have additional walkers and donations or any unused walker envelopes, please drop them off at Crisis Control Ministry by **Friday, November 12, 2021**.

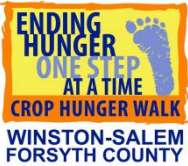

STEPS TO AN EFFECTIVE CROP HUNGER WALK FOR FAITH COMMUNITIES

Arrange with your clergy to include something about world and local hunger in the four Sunday services prior to the CROP Hunger Walk. For example:

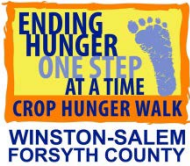
- Week 1** - Introduce the CROP Hunger Walk to your congregation. Set a CROP Walker goal (number of walkers) for your church. Over the next four weeks, use a graphic display like a “thermometer” to tell your congregation how it’s doing.
- Week 2** - Include hunger facts in your worship bulletin. If possible, read additional facts about hunger from the pulpit.
- Week 3** - Do a children’s sermon or Mission Minute about how CROP Walk dollars are making a difference around the world.
- Week 4** - Invite someone from the church who has visited a developing country to share his or her experience.

During this Four Week CROP Hunger Walk Campaign, you can also:

- Follow @cropwalkforsyth on Facebook and share posts on your churches Facebook page. Share the [Facebook event for the Walk](#), or create your own and add @cropwalkforsyth as a co-host.
- Use CROP Hunger Walk bulletin inserts two or three weeks before the walk.
- Photocopy colorful feet for each walker to put his or her name on them. Display feet around a gym or fellowship hall. This provides a great visual of how many people are participating.
- Have a creative container available to collect CROP Hunger Walk donations at the sign-up table from those who are unable to walk.
- Invite a representative from Church World Service, Crisis Control Ministry or Sunnyside Ministry to virtually speak to your congregation or Sunday School Class.
- Encourage people to walk in groups. For example, an adult Sunday School Class or a Youth Group can walk as a service or outreach project. Sunday School Classes can walk together or can walk in friendly competition with each other. Encourage families to sign up together. Remember to walk with masks and social distance.
- Call every individual and family that signed up to remind them about the Walk date, time and place, where you will meet and about how money will be collected.

Remind people: **We Walk Because They Walk – You can walk with the world!**



FUN WAYS TO INSPIRE DONATIONS!

Hot Dog Lunch

You could have a hot dog lunch after church with profits going toward your team goal. Have members of your congregation spread out picnic style in your church parking lot. Practice social distancing as members come up to get their lunch. You could also have it be a drive-through hot dog pickup. With the weather finally cooling down, it's a perfect time for chili!

Sell Footprints

Another easy way to get more donations and bring awareness to the WS/FC CROP Hunger Walk is to sell the footprints that were included in your recruiter's booklet. Just make copies, cut them out and ask those who make a donation to write their name on them and tape them along a hallway or even on the floor to show support for CROP Walk. Host a Virtual Church Dinner

Church dinners are a great time to recruit team members and promote the WS/FC CROP Hunger Walk. Setup a Zoom or Google Meeting for a virtual church dinner. Ask your congregation or Sunday School classes to eat dinner together online. Encourage past Walkers to share what the CROP Hunger Walk means to them as you eat dinner and share the current hunger needs in the community, then encourage attendees to make sign up to walk and/or make a donation online or mail it to you.

Letter to Family & Friends

Write a letter to family and friends telling them why you're walking in the WS/FC CROP Hunger Walk and enclose a self-addressed envelope so they can easily send their contribution to you. Remind them to make checks out to CWS/CROP.

Set up Your Team Online Donation Page

From I-40 traveling west toward Winston-Salem:

1. Exit Hwy. 52 North (Mt. Airy).
2. Go approx. 3.5 miles
3. Take the Liberty St. exit (110 C)
4. At the bottom of the ramp, take sharp left onto Liberty Street.
5. At the next light, turn right onto Patterson Avenue.
6. Take the second left onto Tenth Street. Crisis Control Ministry is located behind the Bethesda Center, on the left.

From 421 traveling east toward Greensboro:

1. Exit onto Hwy. 52 North (Mt. Airy).
2. Go approx. 5 miles and take the Liberty Street exit (110 C)
3. At the bottom of the ramp, take sharp left onto Liberty Street.
4. At the next light, turn right turn right onto Patterson Avenue.
5. Take the second left onto Tenth Street. Crisis Control Ministry is located behind the Bethesda Center, on the left.



CHURCH WORLD SERVICE LIABILITY WAIVER & RELEASE FOR CROP HUNGER WALK PARTICIPANTS

The World Health Organization has declared the novel coronavirus, COVID-19, a worldwide pandemic. Due to the extremely contagious nature of the COVID-19 virus, CHURCH WORLD SERVICE (“CWS”) is taking guidance from recommendations and guidelines set forth by the Center for Disease Control, state and local governments.

In consideration of my participation in the CWS CROP Hunger Walk (“the Walk”), the undersigned acknowledges and agrees to the following:

- I am aware that my participation in the Walk carries a risk of exposure to the COVID-19 virus and other communicable diseases.
- I certify that I have not experienced fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea or exhibiting any other symptoms relating to COVID-19 or any communicable disease within the last 14 days.
- I have not been, nor any member(s) of my household, diagnosed with the COVID-19 virus within the last 14 days.
- I have not been, nor any member(s) of my household, in contact with any person known to have tested positive for the COVID-19 virus within the last 14 days.
- During my participation in the Walk, I will take all recommended precautions with respect to personal protection, including, but not limited to, wearing a mask/face covering, washing hands for at least twenty (20) seconds and/or using hand sanitizer with an alcohol content of at least 60% or greater.
- During my participation in the Walk, I will maintain proper social distancing, at a minimum of six (6) feet, from all other participants, volunteers, organizers and spectators of the Walk.

Further to my acknowledgments above, I hereby declare the following:

I am fully and personally responsible for my own safety and actions while and during my participation in the Walk and I recognize that, as a result of my participation, I may be at risk of contracting COVID-19.

With full awareness and appreciation of the risks involved, I hereby forever release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue CWS, its board member, officers, independent contractors, affiliates, employees, representatives, successors, and assigns (collectively the “Released Parties”) from any and



all liabilities, claims, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever, directly or indirectly arising out of or related to any loss, damage, injury, or death, that may be sustained by me related to COVID-19 while participating in any activity related to the CROP Hunger Walk that may lead to unintentional exposure or harm due to COVID-19.

I agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against any and all costs, expenses, damages, lawsuits, and/or liabilities or claims arising whether directly or indirectly from or related to any and all claims made by or against any of the Released Parties due to injury, loss, or death from or related to COVID-19.

By signing below I acknowledge that I have read the foregoing Liability Waiver and Release and understand its contents; that I am at least eighteen (18) years old and fully competent to give my consent; that I have been sufficiently informed of the risks involved and give my voluntary consent in signing it as my own free act and will; that I give my voluntary consent with full intention to be bound by the same, free from any inducement or representation.

This waiver will remain effective until laws and mandates relevant to the COVID-19 virus are lifted.
